

GENERAL INFORMATION

GOKULDHAM HIGH SCHOOL AND JUNIOR COLLEGE is sponsored by GOENKA & ASSOCIATES EDUCATIONAL TRUST

Day to day affairs of running the school are being managed by the Principal assisted by appropriate staff under overall supervision of the School Committee comprising 3 or 4 representatives of the Trust, the Principal and a representative of the teaching and non-teaching staff. The School Building is spacious with all modern facilities and is designed to accommodate students from Grade. I to Grade XII with a seating capacity of 3,400 students: working in two shifts. The motto of the school reads विद्या विनयेन शोभते which means "MODESTY ADORNS KNOWLEDGE."

The school does not receive any Grant-in-Aid from the Government and the only source of income is the amount of fees collected from the students.

The Trust holds exemption u/s 80G of the Income Tax Act and is registered with the Charity Commissioner under Registration No.E8297 (BOM) dated 17-8-1981 as a Public Charitable Trust with the object to establish and/or run educational institutions.

Any constructive suggestion from the parents whose children are being admitted to the school shall always be welcome. The Trust Office is housed in the Yashodham High School Building, Goregaon (E), Mumbai - 400 063, where such constructive suggestions can be recorded with the Trustee-in-charge.

Parent-Teacher Association has been established on 16.12.1997 vide circular from School Education Department of Government of Maharashtra. Each parent shall be a member of the PTA.

SCHOOL INFORMATION

- GOKULDHAM HIGH SCHOOL & JUNIOR COLLEGE was founded on 2-7-1983. The medium of instruction in the school is English. The school is affiliated to the ICSE Board. Classes are conducted for Grade I to Grade XII (Science & Commerce Sections). The School is permanently unaided.
- 2. The School prepares students for the following examination
 - a) Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE)
 - b) Indian School Certificate (ISC)
- 3. The academic session is from March to February.
- 4. The aim of the school is to develop all the facets of the personality of a student through liberal education and broad curricula. The school stands for academic excellence, development of skills and formation of character through curricular and extra-curricular activities which help to broaden the mental outlook of the students and provide opportunity to discover and develop the latent talents in them.
- 5. A child coming from a recognized school will be admitted only when a School Leaving Certificate from the school he / she has last attended, is produced. The School Leaving Certificate or Transfer Certificate should bear the recognition number of that school, In case of students coming from schools outside Maharashtra State / or from other boards, the School Leaving Certificate must be countersigned by the Educational Inspector of the area in that state from where he / she comes.
- The school has a well-equipped Library, Auditorium, Science Laboratoies and Computer Laboratories with latest equipments and offers Computer Education for both Primary and Secondary Sections.
- 7. a) Hindi / Marathi is taught as Second language from Grade I upwards.
 - b) Hindi or Marathi is offered as 2nd language in Grade IX. French is offered to students with foreign nationality.
- Physical training, and outdoor games are compulsory, unless a doctor's certificate is produced.
- Admission of children to the school is open to all irrespective of caste, creed, religion and sex.
- At the time of admission to the School the age limit prescribed by R.T.E. Act (for Grade I) shall be rigidly adhered to.
- 11. Should the Parent / Guardian feel that his/her child is not making the desired progress the principal should be contacted for guidance. OUR TEACHERS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO OFFER PRIVATE TUITIONS. The Parents are advised to refrain from engaging teachers either from the school or from outside for coaching, as such tuitions normally do more harm than good.
- 12. For the safety of students the school premises is under CCTV surveillance.

RULES REGARDING FEES

- 1. Term fees must be paid in June along with I-Quarter Tuition Fee and in December along with III-Quarter Tuition Fee. Fees can be paid Quarterly, half-yearly or yearly.
- 2. Fees for the months of April and May must be paid along with March fees and this holds good even for those who wish to leave the school in March / April / May.
- 3. The delay of payment beyond 3 months renders a pupil liable to be struck off the roll. If the pupil is re-admitted the admission fee must be paid again.
- 4. If a student is to be withdrawn, one calendar month's notice should be given in writing by the Parent/Guardian to the Principal of the school to arrange for the refund of the balance of tuition fees. In exceptional circumstances of withdrawal, one month's tuition fee in lieu of one calendar month's notice will have to be paid. Amount collected as Term Fee or Tuition Fee will not be refunded.
- 5. Students whose fees are not paid will be considered as defaulters.
- 6. Unless all dues are paid by the student, the results of the examinations/tests conducted by the school will not be communicated to the student. School Leaving Certificate will not be issued till all the outstanding dues from the student at the time of leaving the school are paid and clearance certificate from the concerned authority is obtained.
- 7. Students who leave the school in the month previous to any vacation must pay the fees for the vacation.
- 8. No deduction in fees will be allowed for vacations or for broken period of the month. Full month's fee will be payable if the student's name appears on the roll on the 1st day of the month. Admission fee will not be refunded even if the student, for any reason, leaves the school immediately after securing admission.
- 9. Grade X (ICSE) & Grade XII (ISC) students will have to pay fees till May, **in the month of December.**


